or many Illinois households, energy costs place a severe and continuing stress on the family budget. In some instances, the household is forced to make painful decisions regarding which bills to pay and which necessities to survive without. The Low Income Home Energy Assistance Program (LIHEAP) assists eligible households

with paying for winter heating services. Eligible households are determined by household size, income, geographical location, and type of fuel used.

An overdue bill or disconnect notice is not required. You do not have to own your own home or pay your gas and/or electric bills directly to be eligible for assistance.

When you apply for LIHEAP assistance, be sure to bring the following required information:

- Proof of gross income for all household members for the 30 days prior to and including the date you apply.
- Your most recent heat and/or electric bill(s).
- Social Security cards for all household members.
- If you rent, your lease.
